What Tasks Do You Have To Do?

- Read electrical, architectural and mechanical diagrams, drawings or specifications to determine job requirements.
- Plan the layout of wiring systems.
- Test for, locate and repair electrical malfunctions.
- Install electrical and electronic control systems.
- Assemble and fabricate electrical and electronic components and appliances.
- Connect electrical equipment to power supplies.
- Maintain automated production processes.

How Do You Get A Trade Certificate?

The apprenticeship usually lasts for four years. At the end of your apprenticeship, provided you have successfully completed all on-the-job and off-the-job assessments, you will be issued with a Nationally recognised qualification:

Note: On completion of this qualification, you will be eligible to apply for an electrical licence.
